## WILLIAMSBURG HARVEST SAMPLER

The Williamsburg Harvest Sampler is a traditional sampler measuring 11" wide X 7" high. The sampler uses

28 OLDE Sampler Stitches which include: Cross, Double Cross, Small Cross, Long Arm Cross, Belgian Cross, Marking Cross, Flat (Satin), Satin Stitch Blocks, Back Stitch, Double Back Stitch Double Back Stitch with Bars, Bosnia, Barrier, Colonial Knots, Four-Sided, Italian Hem, Knit, Double Leviathan, Line Stitches, Oriental, Queens, Small Algerian Eyes, Small rice, two Insertion Stitches and two Pulled Thread Satin Stitch Variations. The model is worked on 35-count Northern Cross Belgium Linen, Cream Color.

California Poppies is a (non-charted, pre-drawn) design created with a mixture of sheer fabrics, flosses, novelty threads, and metallic threads and wire. The colors used are indicative of the beautiful bright orange/yellow flowers found growing in abundance in the

California countryside. The leaves are created using whipped open fly stitch and outline stitch in blue/green and yellow/green floss and pearl cottons, and the stems are metallic thread covered wire. NOTE: The student will be given a variety of sheer fabrics to choose from so that they are able to create their own unique flower colors.

## TRES O SEIS

Tres O Seis is a blend of three uniquely different necklaces enhanced by a beautiful and versatile pendant.



The three necklaces may be worn alone and combined with the cabochon pendant or any other pendant that you have in your collection. The necklaces will give students the opportunity to learn three new stitches – Double St. Petersburg Chain, Interrupted Spiral with Crystals and Circular Right Angle Weave. A choice of lapis or malachite is available for the pendant with appropriate color changes for the necklaces.

A look at this garden scene makes one sing of sunshine and summer! Eight distinct bird houses create a small community of birds of all feathers. Each house is a unique shape and stitch pattern. The design measures 8 1/2" X 10 1/2" and uses a variety of threads including cotton, wool, silk, nylon and linen. The ground fabric is pale blue congress cloth. Beautiful floral blooms are reaching up to surround the houses with their fragrant sweetness. The flowers are stitched in a combination of silk and nylon ribbons.
